

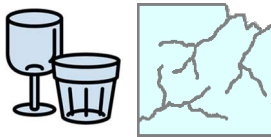
Non-burnable waste can be collected by your neighborhood association **once every two months.**

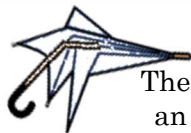

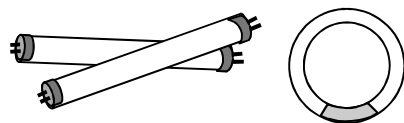

Things to note

Dispose of everything on the same day and in the same place. After remove the package and wrapping paper, you throw it away in the collection container.

- ※ Please do not include electrical appliances and dangerous goods, things that may catch fire, in the container.
- ※ Metals, not applicable, you call the office as bulky waste.
- ※ Please do not place plastic and wooden goods, empty tin and bottle in the container.

How to dispose of waste when a typhoon is coming and it rains heavily.

You give up to dispose of waste on that day, and dispose on the next collection day.

When a special warning is issued in your residential area – a great disaster, very dangerous news, and an evacuation order comes out at 6:00 am, you do not dispose of waste.

How to dispose of waste in Kishiwada City

Simple version
(English)

- You sort and dispose of the waste separately.
- There are rules about what day, when, where and what kind of waste to dispose of.
- The waste collection truck comes to the appointed location where you can leave your waste. You leave the waste there in the morning.
- You ask the neighbor or the landlord where the waste collection point is, and when the collection truck comes.

You check the collection days on the board of the waste collection point.

Ordinary garbage (burnable garbage)

We collect the garbage on the day of every week.

We also collect on holidays.

Ordinary garbage should be placed on a pink colored bag designated by Kishiwada City. The designated bags can be purchased at supermarket, convenience stores etc.

45 liter ¥ 450 (10 pieces)
30 liter ¥ 300 (10 pieces)
20 liter ¥ 200 (10 pieces)
10 liter ¥ 100 (10 pieces)



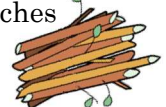
Trash and garbage from daily household life including vegetables waste and fish scraps out of kitchen.



Cigarette litter, tissues, small pieces of paper



A little bit of grass and branches



Plastic products (e.g. a bucket, CD, a toothbrush, a plastic tank, a storage container), clothes, shoes, a stuffed toy, a bag, etc) 「burnable garbage」

Things to note

Drain the water from food waste and throw it away.
Place the garbage in a designated bag, tie it up and throw it away.

Soaked in water



You check the collection days on the board of the waste collection point.

Empty bottles, empty cans, plastic bottles

We collect the garbage on the day of every week.

We also collect on holidays.

Place empty bottles, empty cans and plastic bottles in a bag with visible contents and smaller than a 45L bag.

Empty bottles of food, drinks and seasonings.



Empty juice cans and empty beer cans



Empty sweets tins



Empty canned food tins

Plastic bottles < place anything with the plastic(プラ)mark on it >



Gas cartridges, spray cans.

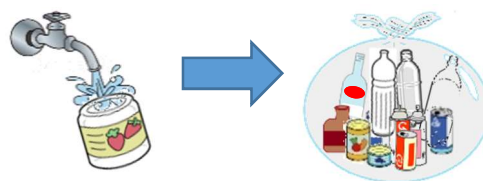
Use all up, drill a hole in the can outdoors and throw it away.



Things to note

Rinse them with water, then put them in a bag with visible contents.

Put them in a bag with visible contents, tie them up and throw them away.



Plastic containers and packaging

We collect the garbage on the day of every week.

We also collect on holidays.

Place plastic containers and packaging in a bag with visible contents and smaller than a 45 L bag.



Place anything with the plastic(プラ) mark on it.

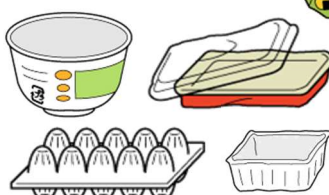


Shampoo and detergent containers

Bread and snack wrappers, exterior film, plastic shopping bags.



Plastic bottle caps and labels.



Containers for instant noodles, convenience store bento boxes etc.
Packs for eggs, tofu, etc.

Things to note

Items without the plastic(プラ)mark should be disposed of as ordinary garbage (burnable garbage)

Dispose of dirty trash as ordinary garbage (burnable garbage)

Rinse them with water, then put them in a bag with visible contents.

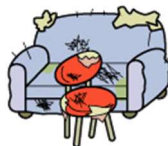
Bulky goods (non-burnable and large items)

- You call our office and apply for disposal.
- There is a fee.

- The fee varies depending on the number and items you throw away.

Bulky goods disposal ticket	Type classification
¥500	¥500 ticket : a 45L bag or an item of the total length of the three sides (height, width, depth) is within 3 meters.
¥1000 (Two ¥500 tickets)	¥1000 ticket : an item of the total length of the three sides (height, width, depth) is over 3 meters.



- The disposal ticket can be purchased at supermarket and convenience store.

If there is waste that Kishiwada City does not collect, ask the store where you bought it.

✖ Air conditioners, televisions (cathode-ray tube, LCD screen-plasma), refrigerators, washing machines and cloth dryers cannot be disposed of as bulky waste.

✖ Computers are collected and recycled by the manufacturer and cannot be thrown away as bulky waste. For more information, call the PC 3R Promotion Association on “03-5282-7685”.

✖ Motorcycle (Mini-bike [motorbike]) cannot be disposed of as bulky waste. You ask Japan Automobile Recycling Promotion Center(JARC) on “050-3000-0727”
